In the Matter of Nathaniel Antill Limited and Reduced and in the Matter of the Companies Act 1867 and in the Matter of the Companies Act 1877.

NOTICE is hereby given that by an Order of the High Court of Justice made by Mr. Justice Chitty on the 5th day of December 1896 in the above mentioned matter it was ordered that a Special Resolution passed at an Extraordinary General Meeting of the Company held on the 26th day of May 1896 and confirmed at an Extraordinary General Meeting of the Company held on the 15th day of June 1896 be confirmed. And it was ordered that the words "and reduced" should form part of the name of the said Company for one month from the date of the said Order. And notice is hereby also given that the said

Order has been produced to the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies and a copy thereof has been delivered to him together with the Minute approved by the said Judge in the words and figures following namely:—"The capital of Nathaniel Antill Limited is henceforth £4,000 divided into 8,000 shares of 10s. each instead of the original capital of £40,000 divided into 8,000 shares of £5 each.
