(Winding-up).

No. 0043 of 1897.

In the Matter of the Companies Acts 1862 to 1890, and in the Matter of the Theatrical Comedy Syndicate, Limited.

NOTICE is hereby given, that a petition for the compulsory winding up of the above named Company by the High Court of Justice was, on the 18th day of February 1897, presented to the said Court by Francis Francis of No. 104 Mount-street Grosvenor-square, in the county of Middlesex a creditor of the said Company.
