BY an Order made by Mr. Justice Byrne (acting for Mr. Justice Vaughan Williams) in the above matters dated the 22nd day of February 1897 on the two several petitions of (1) Charles Case and Walter Edward Case trading as Charles Case and Son all of Frome in the county of Somerset Tanners and Copartners creditors of the above-named Company and (2) of John Clark Jackson Clark Ledlie Clark and Charles Clark trading as L. Clark and Co. at 29 York-street in the city of Manchester creditors of the above named Company George Ashdown of 56 Gresham-street in the city of London Chartered Accountant was upon his giving security appointed a Liquidator of the said Company jointly with Augustus Cufaude Palmer one of the voluntary Liquidators thereof (Mr. Butcher the other voluntary Liquidator thereof consenting to retire) and it was ordered on both the said petitions that the voluntary winding up of the said Brice and Company Limited be continued but subject to the supervision of the Court and any of the proceedings under the said voluntary winding up might be adopted as the Court should think fit. And it was ordered that the costs of the said several petitioners and of the said Company and of the creditors and contributories supporting the said petitions be taxed and paid out of the assets of the said Company but on such taxation only one set of costs was to be allowed the creditors supporting and one set to the contributories supporting and the creditors

contributories and Liquidators of the said Company and all other persons interested were to be at liberty to apply as there might be occasion and the time within which the said Order was to be gazetted was extended until the 10th of March 1897.—Dated the 8th day of March 1897.
