A Composition of 7s. 6d. in the pound on all provable debts, shall be paid in cash in two instalments of 3s. 6d. and 4s. respectively:—The first instalment of 3s. 6d. within fourteen days after the approval by the Court of this Composition, and the second instalment at six months from the date of such approval. Payment of the Composition secured by the deposit with the Official Receiver within seven days from the date of the approval of the Composition by the Court of a sum sufficient to pay the first instalment, such deposit being guaranteed by a person or persons approved of by the Official Receiver, and the payment of the second instalment being secured by the guarantee of a person or persons to be approved of by the Official Receiver and the Court
