

In the High Court of Justice.—Companies (Winding-up).  
Mr. Justice Vaughan Williams.  
No. 00271 of 1896.

In the Matter of the Companies Acts, 1862 to 1890, and  
in the Matter of the Auriferous Properties Limited.
