WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Saint Agnes, in the county of Cornwall, and in the diocese of Truro, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all and singular the yearly rectorial tithe commutation rent-charges particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and now vested in us: To have and to hold the said yearly rectorial tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever. Provided always, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the profits and proceeds of the said yearly rectorial tithe commutation rent charges hereby granted and conveyed for and in respect of the period intervening between the first day of January, in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette. Provided also that the annexation hereby made shall be and be deemed to be in lieu of and in substitution for the arrangements heretofore in force under which the proceeds of a certain portion of the tithe rentcharges of the said parish of Saint Agnes was payable to the Incumbent thereof.
