"ORDER of the Local Government Board : Making certain Orders applicable to Separate Parish :-

Parish of Canterbury.

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Parish of Canterbury ;-

To the Overseers of the Poor of the said Parish ;-- .

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS in pursuance of an Order of the Council of the County Borough of Canterbury, dated the 1st day of July, 1896, which was con-firmed by Us, the Local Government Board, by the Canterbury Confirmation Order, 1897, the Parishes of All Saints, Black Prince's Chantry, East Bridge Hospital, Holy Cross Westgate, Old Castle, Saint Alphage, Saint Andrew the Apostle, Saint Augustine, Saint George the Martyr, Saint John's Hospital, Saint Margaret, Saint Martin, Saint Mary Bredin, Saint Mary Bredman, Saint Mary Magdalen, Saint Mary North Gate, Saint Mildred, Saint Paul, Saint Peter, and White Friars House, forming the Canterbury Union, were on the 26th day of March, 1897, united to form one Parish, and called the Parish of Canterbury ;
