Apportionment confirmed	14th June, 1845:				

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction consisting of three hundred pounds sterling which has been paid to us in favour of the vicarage of Saint Chrysostom, Birmingham, in the county of Warwick, and in the diocese of Worcester, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, sections five and eleven, grant and appropriate out of our common fund to the said vicarage of Saint Chrysostom, Birmingham, to meet such benefaction, one other capital sum of three hundred pounds sterling, to be applicable towards defraying the cost of providing a parsonage or house of

residence for the said vicarage according to plans and a specification approved or to be approved by us, such capital sum, or the balance thereof unapplied to such purpose, to remain in the meantime in our hands at interest after the rate of two pounds and ten shillings per centum per annum, and such interest to be paid to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage of Saint Chrysostom, Birmingham.

In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our common seal, this fifteenth day of July, in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven.
