boundary at high water mark to the point of on the Tyne Dock Basin, the lock, and Tyne commencement aforesaid.

Westoe Ward. No. 6.

"And I do hereby determine that Westoe Ward shall comprise so much of the borough as is contained within a line commencing from the point of intersection of the Whitburn Railway with the borough boundary and running in a north-westerly directon along the boundary of No. 5 Ward as hereinbefore defined to the centre of the Whitburn Railway bridge over Westoelane, thence in a south-westerly direction along the centre of the Whitburn Railway to Laygatelane thence in a south-easterly direction to and along the centre of Laygate-lane to Westoeparade, thence to and along the centre of Westoeparade to Mortimer-road thence to and along the centre of Mortimer-road to the borough boundary, thence in a north-easterly direction along the said borough boundary to the point of commencement aforesaid.

"No. 8. Rekendyke Ward.

"And I do hereby determine that Rekendyke Ward shall comprise so much of the borough as is contained within a line commencing from the point of intersection of Dean-lane with Laygatelane, thence in a north-westerly direction along the boundary of No. 6 Ward to the Whitburn Railway thence along the south-west boundary of No. 7 Ward to the point of intersection in Laygate-lane of No. 3 Ward and the said No. 7 Ward as hereinbefore defined, thence in a westerly and southerly direction along the boundary of the said No. 3 Ward to Smith-street Tunnel, thence in an easterly direction to and along the centre of Bertram-street to Eglesfield-road thence along the centre of Eglesfield-road to Dean-lane thence in a north-easterly direction to and along the centre of Dean-lane to the point of commencement aforesaid.

"No. 9. Deans Ward.

"And I do hereby determine that Deans Ward shall comprise so much of the borough as is contained within a line commencing at the borough boundary at its junction with Mortimer-road thence in a north-westerly direction along the boundary of No. 6 Ward as hereinbefore defined, to the point of intersection of the said No. 6 Ward with No. 8 Ward, thence in a southwesterly and westerly direction along the boundary of the said No. 8 Ward, to the point of intersection of No. 3 Ward with the said No. 8 Ward, thence in a westerly direction along the boundary of the said No. 3 Ward to the borough boundary in the centre of the river, thence in a straight line in a southerly direction to the ferry boat landing thence along the ferry boat landing to the dock wall thence along the dock wall abutting and R. H. Pettler.

"And I do hereby determine that Tyne Dock Ward shall comprise so much of the borough as is contained within a line commencing at the junction of Talbot-road with the borough boundary, thence in a north-easterly direction along the boundary of No. 9 Ward as hereinbefore defined to the centre of the River Tyne thence in a westerly direction along the centre of the said river to a point opposite the borough boundary lying to the west of Tyne Dock, thence in a southerly and easterly direction along the borough boundary to the said junction of Talbotroad with the borough boundary the point of commencement aforesaid.

"And I do hereby further declare that the wards hereinbefore determined and defined are shown upon the plan (marked in red 'Plan No. 2') hereunto annexed and signed by me; and that the said boundaries of the said wards are

clearly set forth by red lines thereon.
