In the Matter of the Companies (Memorandum of Association) Act 1890 and in the Matter of Lawes Chemical Manure Company Limited.

NOTICE is hereby given that a petition presented to the High Court of Justice Chancery Division on the 1st day of November 1898 for confirming the following Special Resolution passed on the 26th day of August 1898 and confirmed on the 22nd day of September 1898:—
