Bury Corporation Water.

(Construction of New Waterworks; Diversion of Roads and Footpaths; Closing of Footpaths; Compulsory Purchase of Lands for Waterworks purposes; Construction of Water Pipes through Streets, Lands, and Premises, and Compulsory Easements therefor; Compulsory Purchase of Lands for Protection of Waters and Waterworks from Pollution; Alteration and Increase of Water Rates, Rents, and Charges; Borrowing of Money; Issue of Corporation Stock; Application and Alteration of Existing Funds, Rates, and Revenues, and Levying of Additional Water and other Rates; Amendment and Incorporation of Acts; and for other purposes.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the ensuing Session by the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the county borough of Bury, in the county Palatine of Lancaster (hereinafter called "the Corporation") for an Act for all or some of the following objects or purposes (that is to say):—

To enable the Corporation to make, construct, and maintain the following waterworks and all other works which may be necessary and connected therewith (that is to say):—

(1) A reservoir, to be called "the Ogden Reservoir," to be situate on the Ogden Brook, wholly in the township or parish of Haslingden, the embankment of which reservoir will be placed 6 chains or thereabouts, measured in a straight line in a westerly direction up the said brook from the point where the centre of the Mineral Tramway Line crosses the said brook, at which embankment the reservoir will commence, and thence extend up such brook in a westerly direction for a distance of 48 chains or thereabouts, measured in a straight line, and will there terminate.

(2) An aqueduct, conduit, or line of pipes to commence in the said embankment of the intended Ogden Reservoir at a point, 9 chains or thereabouts, measured in a straight line in a westerly direction up the said brook from the point where the centre of the Mineral Tramway Line crosses the said brook, and to terminate in the Black Carr Reservoir of the Corporation, situate in the township or parish of Bury.

(3) A service reservoir situate at Slates, wholly in the township or parish of Haslingden, in a field there No. 916 on the Ordnance Map, Lancashire, Sheet LXXI, 12, 1892; belonging to the Corporation of Bury.

(4) An aqueduct, conduit, or line of pipes

situate wholly in the township or parish of Haslingden, and to commence by a junction with the existing main pipe of the Corporation of Bury on land belonging to the said Corporation, at a point south of the present service reservoir of the said Corporation at Holden Wood, and terminating in the said intended service reservoir at Slates.

To empower the Corporation to make and maintain all such cuts, channels, adits, catchwaters, aqueducts, culverts, tunnels, drains, sluices, byewashes, weirs, gauges, reservoirs, filters, filterbeds, wells, tanks, embankments, bridges, roads, approaches, telegraphic and telephonic apparatus, engines, machinery, and appliances as may be necessary or convenient in connection with the before-mentioned works or any of them.

All which said intended works will be made and situate within the townships or parishes of Haslingden, Ramsbottom, Walmersley-cum-Shuttleworth, and Bury, in the county of Lancaster.

To incorporate with the Bill and to apply to the aforesaid works or any of them the provisions or some of the provisions of the Railways Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845, with respect to the temporary occupation of lands near the railway during the construction thereof.

To empower the Corporation to deviate laterally from the lines or vertically from the levels of the aforesaid works to such extent as may be defined upon the plans and sections to be deposited as hereinafter mentioned or specified in the Bill.

To empower the Corporation from time to time to cross, open, or break up, alter, divert, or stop up or otherwise interfere with, either temporarily or permanently, any turnpike or other roads, lanes, streets, highways, footpaths, bridges, rivers, canals, towing paths, streams, watercourses, sewers, drains, railways, tramways, navigations, gas, water, and other pipes, and telegraph and other electrical apparatus or other works within the townships or parishes aforesaid.

To empower the Corporation to purchase and acquire, compulsorily or by agreement, and to hold lands, houses, buildings, rights of water and other hereditaments, together with any mines or minerals under any of such lands within the townships or parishes aforesaid, or terms, estates, interests, easements, rights, or privileges in, over, or affecting the same, and to sell and dispose of or let on lease any such lands, houses, and property; and the Bill will or may vary or extinguish all or any rights, easements, or privileges in, over, or affecting any lands, which or any term, estate, interest, easement, right, or privilege in, over, or affecting which the Corporation may purchase, acquire, or take as aforesaid.

To enable the Corporation to collect and impound, take, use, appropriate, and divert into the said intended Ogden Reservoir the waters of the stream known as the Ogden Brook, and also all such springs, streams, waters, and watercourses as will or may be intercepted by the same reservoir, and the works connected therewith.

To empower the Corporation to lay down, construct, maintain, and from time to time inspect and renew the mains or lines of pipes for conveying and distributing water into, through, or under any roads, streets, lands, and premises within the district of the Corporation for the supply of water, and to create and acquire permanent easements or wayleaves in or over lands or premises traversed by such conduits,
