1000 feet or thereabouts towards "The Bee Stone," to, and terminating at, the spring supplying Bee Stone House.

Together with all cuts, channels, adits, catchwaters, aqueducts, culverts, tunnels, drains, sluices, bye-washes, weirs, gauges, wells, tanks, filter beds, dams, walls, bridges, roads, approaches, engines, machinery, buildings, and appliances necessary or convenient to the said works, or for the inspection, maintenance, cleansing, and working the same.

All the intended works will be wholly situate in the township of Burley, in the parish of Otley, in the West Riding of the county of York.

To empower the Council to divert, collect, impound, take, and use for the purpose of the Bill, or other the purposes of their water undertaking, all such springs, streams, and waters on Burley Common as will or may be intercepted or taken by the intended works, and especially the following streams, viz., Carr Beck and Coldstones Beck, which streams now flow directly or indirectly into the River Wharfe.

To empower the Council to purchase or acquire by compulsion or agreement rights or easements in, under, over, or connected with any lands, houses or buildings, or any mineral interests therein, for the purposes of the intended works and of the Bill.

Also to acquire by compulsion certain areas of land on Burley Common, otherwise Burley Moor, in the said township of Burley, in the parish of Otley in the West Riding of the county of York, viz. :---

- (a) An area of land for the purposes of the said Carr Bottom Reservoir, estimated to contain 11 acres or thereabouts.
- (b) An area of land around Upper Lanshaw Reservoir, estimated to contain $19\frac{1}{2}$ acres or thereabouts.
- (c) An area of land around Lower Lanshaw Reservoir, estimated to contain $2\frac{1}{2}$ acres or thereabouts, together with all mineral and other rights and interests therein; the said areas (a), (b), and (c) being estimated to contain an aggregate of 33 acres or thereabouts.

To authorise the Council to deviate laterally from the lines of the intended works as shown upon the plans thereof, to be deposited as hereinafter mentioned to such extent as may be indicated on those plans, and to deviate vertically from the levels of those works as shown upon the deposited sections thereof, to be deposited as hereinafter mentioned to such extent as the Bill may prescribe.

To empower the Council to purchase and take or acquire by compulsion or agreement, or to take on lease, and to hold within the parishes aforesaid, lands, streams, springs, waters, houses, and hereditaments, and rights, and easements in, over, or connected with lands, streams, springs, waters, houses, and hereditaments, for the purposes of constructing the said intended works, or for other purposes of the Bill, or of their waterworks undertaking.

To authorise the Council to acquire by agreement and to confirm any agreement for that, purpose that māy have been made or may be made before the passing of the Bill, and to hold the lands near the said intended Carr Bottom Reservoir and within the natural drainage area of the said intended reservoir, and to authorise the Council to hold any lands which they may acquire under the powers of the Bill free from the provisions of the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845, with respect to superfluons lands,

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and, if thought fit, to acquire by compulsion or agreement, any mines or minerals under any such lands, notwithstanding the provisions of the Waterworks Clauses Act, 1847, with respect to mines.

To empower the Council so far as may be necessary for executing the purposes of the Bill to lay down, maintain, and renew or remove mains, pipes, conduits, and other works and apparatus for the supply of water along, through, over, and across, and to break open, cross, alter, raise, lower, stop up, divert, or interfere with (temporarily or permanently) highways, public and private streets and roads, bridges, railways, tramroads, tramways, canals, towing paths, sewers, drains, culverts, rivers, streams, watercourses, footpaths, ways, passages, and other places, and to alter the position of, remove, and interfere with (temporarily or permanently) gas and water mains, pipes, and works, telegraphic, telephonic, and electric pipes, lines; wires, posts, and apparatus, and any other works laid or placed in, under, along, or over any such highways, streets, roads, bridges, footpaths, ways, passages, and places.

To fix the limits within which the Council are authorised to supply water, and to confer upon the Council all necessary powers to supply water for all domestic, trade, and other purposes, public and private, within the district of the Council, and to authorise the Council within such limits to levy, demand, and take rates, rents, and charges, and to exercise, subject to the provisions of the Bill, all or some of the powers of the Council under the Bill, in relation to the supply of water.

To authorise the Council on the one hand, and any local or sanitary authority, county, district, or parish council, corporation, company, trustees, bodics, persons or person (corporate or not corporate) on the other hand, to enter into and carry into effect, and to vary or rescind contracts and agreements for the sale or supply by the Council from their intended works of water in bulk by measure or otherwise, to any such authority, corporation, trustee, bodies, persons, or person for use either within or beyond the limits for the supply of water by the Council, on such terms and conditions as may be agreed between them or the Bill may prescribe.

To empower the Council for the purposes of the Bill to raise further money, and to charge the same by mortgage, or other means, on the general district fund and general district rate, and upon the revenue of their waterworks undertaking, and the rates and revenues to arise under the Bill, or other funds, rates, and revenues of or under the control of the Council, or on any of the funds, rates, and revenues aforesaid as they may determine.

To confirm or otherwise to give effect to any agreements which may be made before the passing of the Bill touching any of the matters mentioned or contained in this Notice.

To incorporate with the Bill or make applicable thereto with such alterations, moditications, or exceptions as may be deemed necessary or expedient all or some of the provisions of the Lands Clauses Acts, the Waterworks Clauses Acts, 1847 and 1863, the Local Loans Act, 1875, and the Public Health Acts, 1875 and 1878, and of any Acts amending or extending the same Acts respectively, and if thought fit to exempt the Council from the provisions of Section 35 of the Waterworks Clauses Act, 1847.
