

the gauge of 3 feet, and the motive power to be employed thereon will be animal, rope, traction, or haulage by means of wire or rope cables, laid above or below the surface of the ground and worked by stationary engines. The intended tramroad will not be fenced otherwise than as in the Bill prescribed.

3. To authorise the District Council, in connection with the said tramroad, to make and maintain all necessary and proper rails, plates, sleepers, junctions, passing-places, sidings, loops, stables, engines, engine-houses, sheds, buildings, arches, piers, abutments, embankments, works, and conveniences connected therewith or incidental thereto.

4. To authorise the District Council from time to time, in connection with the before-mentioned shafts and pumping stations, tank, aqueduct, and service tank, to make and maintain or lay down all cuts, channels, adits, shafts, catchwaters, aqueducts, culverts, tunnels, drains, sluices, bywashes, weirs, gauges, gauge-basins, reservoirs, tanks, basins, wells, bore-holes, water-towers, filter-beds, banks, walls, roads, ways, approaches, pipes, engines, pumps, machinery, telegraphic and telephonic apparatus, and other appliances as may be necessary or convenient for obtaining, filtering, storing, distributing, using, and preventing the fouling, waste, misuse, and undue consumption of their water, or for the general purposes of their Water Undertaking.

5. To authorise the District Council to deviate from the lines and levels of the proposed works shewn on the plans and sections, to be deposited as hereinafter mentioned, to such extent as may be prescribed by the Bill.

6. To authorise the District Council, for the purposes of the proposed works, to lay down and maintain, renew, and alter mains, pipes, meters, stop-cocks, and apparatus in, through, along, over, under, and across, and for that purpose to break up, cross, alter, divert, stop up, and interfere with, either temporarily or permanently, and if permanently to appropriate the site and soil of public and private streets, roads, lanes, footways, thoroughfares, rivers, brooks, water-courses, streams, railways, tramways, sewers, drains, pipes, tubes, and telegraphic and telephonic, and other electric apparatus.

7. To authorise the District Council, for the purpose of the proposed works, or any of them, or any part or parts thereof respectively, and other the purposes of the intended Act, or of their Undertaking, to purchase or acquire compulsorily and by agreement, or to take on lease and hold lands, houses, or buildings, and other hereditaments, and also easements, rights, and privileges in, over, or affecting lands and hereditaments, and to empower the District Council to appropriate to all or any of the purposes of the intended Act any lands for the time being vested in them.

8. To authorise the temporary occupation and use of lands, houses, buildings, easements, and hereditaments, for obtaining materials for the construction of the before-mentioned works, or otherwise for the purposes of the intended Act, and to incorporate, with such variations and amendments as may be proper or requisite, all or some of the provisions of the Railways Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845, with respect to the temporary occupation of lands near the railway during the construction thereof, and to make other provisions with reference thereto.

9. To authorise the District Council, for the protection of their waterworks, to hold any lands which they may acquire under the authority of

the intended Act free from the provisions of the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845, with respect to superfluous lands, and to empower the District Council to acquire by compulsion or agreement any mines or minerals under any lands proposed to be taken, notwithstanding the provisions of the Waterworks Clauses Act, 1847, with respect to mines.

10. To authorise the District Council to purchase and acquire by compulsion or otherwise, for the purposes of their Water Undertaking, and to hold or to demise or otherwise deal with Certain lands in the hamlet or township of Rhigos, in the parish of Ystrad-y-fodwg aforesaid, being part of the enclosures numbered 583 and 585 on the Ordnance Map of scale of the said hamlet or township of Rhigos, lying to the northward of the Llynfawr Lake and adjoining lands which the District Council are empowered to acquire under the Ystrad-y-fodwg Urban District Council (Gas and Water) Act, 1896, and which lands are shewn on the plans to be deposited as hereinafter mentioned.

11. To authorise the District Council to sell, lease, and dispose of, on such terms and conditions as they may think fit, any lands acquired by them and not required for the purposes of the intended Act.

12. To provide for extending the powers of the District Council in regard to the constructing, laying down, and maintenance of conduits, mains, pipes, culverts, sluices, wells, tanks, cisterns, machinery buildings, works, and conveniences for the purposes of their Water Undertaking, and to make all or some of the provisions of the Public Health Acts applicable to such works; for the recovery of water rents, rates, and charges, and to make them preferential payments in the case of bankruptcy, and in other respects to make better provision in regard to the water supply of the District Council.

13. To constitute the works proposed to be authorised by the intended Act part of the Water Undertaking of the District Council, and to extend and apply all or some of the enactments now in force in relation to the existing Water Undertaking of the District Council to the works so proposed to be authorised.

14. To prescribe the mode of applying the revenue derived from the Gas and Water Undertakings of the District Council, and to provide for meeting any deficiencies in such revenue.

15. To empower the District Council to borrow or raise money for the intended works or other the purposes of the intended Act and the Gas and Water Undertakings of the District Council, and to charge the moneys so proposed to be borrowed on the District Fund and General District Rate or other local rates, and the estates, undertakings, tolls, rates, rents, revenues, and other property of the District Council, or any one or more of such securities, and to execute, grant, and issue mortgages, stock, debentures, and annuities in respect thereof, and to authorise the District Council to apply any of their funds, or any money borrowed or authorised to be borrowed under any former Act, to all or any of the purposes of the intended Act.

16. To authorise the District Council to consolidate their loans, or some of them, and to equate the periods or some of the periods for the discharge of loans contracted by them, and to consolidate all the Sinking Funds or some of them, and to provide for the applica-
