from the manufacture of gas, within the city of St. David's, the Cathedral Close, and also within the parishes of St. David's and Whitchurch, in the county of Pembroke.

To empower the Company to make and maintain the following works necessary for the supply

of water aforesaid:

A well or wells and pumping station situate at Nine Wells, in the parish of St. David's, in the county of Pembroke, on the waste land or common known as Morfa Common, otherwise Llandruidion, at a point about 50 yards or thereabouts measured in a southwesterly direction from the bench mark on the south-west corner of the cottage on the north side of the public road at Nine Wells aforesaid.

A service tank to be situate at the eastern end of the field No. 307 on the Ordnance Map scale ½ 500 (published 1887) of the parish of St. David's.

An aqueduct, conduit, or line of pipes (No. 1). to be situate wholly in the parish of St. David's, commencing in the said well or wells and pumping station, and terminating in the said service tank.

An aqueduct, conduit, or line of pipes (No. 2), to be situated wholly in the parish of St. David's, in the said service tank, and terminating in the city of St. David's at a point in the public road leading from Solva to St. David's, called High-street, 25 yards or thereabouts measured in an easterly direction from the Cross.

An aqueduct, conduit, or line of pipes (No. 3), to be situate partly in the parish of St. David's and partly in the parish of Whitchurch, commencing by a junction with conduit No. 1 at a point 66 yards measured along the line of that conduit from its commencement, and terminating in the parish of Whitchurch at a point in the public road leading from Solva to Middle Mill 16 chains or thereabouts north-east of the Cambrian Hotel.

Together with all necessary approaches, excavations, embankments, aluices, culverts, pipes, tunnels, channels, adits, levels, drains, weirs, outfalls, valves, wells, pumps, filters, filter beds, and other conveniences and appliances connected therewith.

To authorise the Company to purchase and take for the purposes of their Undertaking certain land being or reputed to be common or commonable lands, of which the following are particulars and the estimated quantities pro-

posed to be taken, namely:

such extent in either case as may be prescribed by the Bill.

To authorise the Company, to break up, alter, divert, or stop up, either temporarily or permanently, any roads, streets, highways, footpaths, bridges, streams, watercourses, sewers, drains, telegraphic or telephonic wires within any of the parishes and places aforesaid, which it may be necessary or convenient to break up, alter, divert, or stop up for the purposes of the intended works or of the Bill.

To authorise the Company to purchase and acquire by compulsion or agreement and hold houses, lands, buildings, easements, waters, and other property for the purposes of the Bill and of their Undertaking, and to extinguish all rights in or over any such lands and property, and to sell and dispose of any surplus lands or buildings, and to exempt the Company from the provisions of the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845, with respect to surplus lands.

To enable the Company, subject to the provisions of the Bill, to take, collect, impound, use and appropriate for the purposes of the proposed Waterworks and Water Undertaking all such springs, streams, and waters as will or may be intercepted by the intended works, or which may be found in, over, or under lands in or over which they have or may acquire easements or

other rights.

To authorise the Company, upon lands hereinafter described, to erect, construct, maintain, continue, repair, enlarge, renew, and use gasworks and works connected therewith, with all necessary buildings, gasholders, receivers, purifiers, rotorts, meters and apparatus, works and conveniences for the manufacture and storage of gas and residual products, and at such works to manufacture, store, and sell gas, coke, culm, tar, oil, pitch, asphaltum, ammoniacal liquor, and other residual products arising or resulting from the manufacture of gas or other matters connected therewith, and to exercise all such powers, rights, and privileges as are usually conferred on Gas Companies.

The lands hereinbefore referred to are certain pieces or parcels of land containing by admeasurement 1 acre 2 roods and 5 perches or thereabouts, and numbered 498, part 517 and part 518 on the 25-inch Ordnance Map (published in 1889) of the parish of St. David's, in the county of Pembroke, and adjoining the public

road at Porthclais.

To purchase by agreement or take on lease or otherwise acquire for the general purposes of the Company, other than the manufacture and storage of gas, such other lands, buildings, and
