town Linford. Work No. 39A. Aqueduct No. 4A.—A branch or line of pipes, wholly in the said parish of Newtown Linford commencing in Aqueduct No. 4 at the north end of the private road to the said existing Hall Gates reservoir, and terminating in the intended low level Hall Gates, reservoir hereinafter

described.

Work No. 39B. Aqueduct No. 4B.—A branch or line of pipes, wholly in the said parish of Newtown Linford, commencing in Aqueduct No. 4 near the said existing Hall Gates reservoir, and terminating in the intended high level Hall Gates reservoir hereinafter described.

Work No. 40. Hall Gates Low Level Service Reservoir.—A low level service reservoir at Hall Gates, in the said parish of Newtown Linford, in the field or enclosure numbered 251 on the \(\frac{1}{2500}\) Leicestershire Ordnance map, No. XXIV, 12.

Work No. 41. Hall Gates High Level Service Reservoir.—A high level service reservoir at Hall Gates, in the said parish of Newtown Linford, in the same enclosure in which is the said existing Hall Gates reservoir, upon-land now belonging to the Corporation.

Work No. 42. Line of Pipes No. 1.—An aqueduct, consisting of one or more lines of pipes, with branches and washouts at all streams

crossed, commencing at the said intended low level Hall Gates service reservoir, in the said parish of Newtown Linford, and passing through the said parish of Newtown Linford, the parishes of Cropston and Anstey, and the parishes of Beaumont Leys and Gilroes, in the rural district of Barrow-upon-Soar, or some of them, in the County of Leicester, and terminating at the existing Gilroes service reservoir of the

Corporation.

Work No. 43. Line of Pipes No. 2.—An aqueduct, consisting of one or more lines of pipes, with branches and washouts at all streams crossed, commencing in the road from Sheepshed to Cropston, in the said parish of Newtown Linford, at the northern end of the private road leading to the said existing Hall Gates reservoir, by a junction with the intended Aqueduct No. 4, and passing through the said parishes of Newtown Linford and Cropston, the parish of Birstall, the parish of Thurcaston in the Rural District of Barrow upon - Soar, the said parish of Beaumont Leys, the parish of Leicester in the county borough of Leicester, the parish of Humberstone, and the parishes of Evington and Stoughton, in the Rural District of Billesdon, or some of them, in the county of Leicester, and terminating in the intended Stoughton service reservoir hereinaster described.

Work No.43A. Line of Pipes No.2A.—A short branch or line of pipes about 40 yards in length from the line of pipes No. 2 in Coleman-road, in the said parish of Evington, to the intended Evington Service reservoir

hereinafter described.

Work No. 44. Evington Service Reservoir.-A service reservoir in the said parish of Evington, situated in the field numbered 300 on the \(\frac{1}{3\cdot 00}\) Leicestershire Ordnance map, No. XXXI, 16.

Work No. 45. Evington Overflow.—A line of pipes in the said parish of Evington, commencing at the intended Princeton and parish of Evington.

ing at the intended Evington service reservoir, and terminating at the Evington brook where it is crossed at Shady Lane.

Work No.46. Stoughton Service Reservoir .-A service reservoir in the said parish of Stoughton, situated in the field numbered 125 on the 1500 Leicestershire Ordnance map, No. XXXVIII, 5.

Work No. 47. Stoughton Overflow .- A line of pipe in the said parish of Stoughton, commencing at the said intended Stoughton service reservoir, and terminating at the stream in enclosure numbered 113 on the Leicestershire Ordnance map, No. XXXVIII. 1, at the south side of the Gartreeroad.

Tork No. 48. Line of Pipes, No. 3.—An aqueduct consisting of one or more lines of pipes with washout at Humberstone Work No. 48. Brook in the said parishes of Evington and Leicester, commencing at the said intended Evington service reservoir and terminating at the south-west end of Overton-road in the said parish of Leicester by a junction with the existing main of the Corporation.

Work No. 49.—Line of Pipes No. 4.—An aqueduct consisting of one or more lines of pipes in the said parishes of Evington and Leicester and the parish of Oadby in the County of Leicester, commencing by a junction with the said intended line of pipes No. 2, at the south end of Shady-lane, in the said parish of Evington, and terminating at the west end of Stoughton-lane in the
