WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Incumbent for the time being of the vicarage of Saint Luke, Barton Hill, Bristol, in the city and the county of the city of Bristol, and in the diocese of Bristol, one yearly sum or stipend of sixty pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the first day of November, in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight, and to be receivable in four equal portions, on the first day of February, the 1 to us appear to be expedient under the circum-

first day of May, the first day of August, and the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always, that the annual sum or stipend so granted by us to the Incumbent of the said vicarage shall be paid only upon the production to us on or after each of the said lastly-mentioned days in each and every year of a certificate under the hand of the Bishop of the said diocese of Bristol, that an Assistant-Curate, duly licensed by such Bishop, has been employed within the parish of Saint Luke, Barton Hill, Bristol aforesaid, during the quarter of the year then ended: Provided also, that such yearly sum or stipend shall continue payable as aforesaid so long only as may
