ORDER of the Local Government Board: District Auditors Act, 1879: Assignment of Districts and Duties (Supplemental):—

Nottinghamshire Audit District.

North Derbyshire Hospital Committee.

To Arthur George Chamberlin, District Auditor;—

To the North Derbyshire Hospital Committee;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by Section 4 of "The District Auditors Act, 1879," it is enacted that the Local Government Board may from time to time assign to District Auditors their Duties, and the Districts in which such Auditors respectively are to act, and may from time to time change wholly or in part such Duties or Districts;

And whereas by an Order dated the 23rd day of March, 1882, We, the Local Government Board, certified the appointment of the said Arthur George Chamberlin as a District Auditor, and ordered that the District in which he should in future act as Auditor, and which should be termed "The Nottinghamshire Audit District," should, for the performance of the duties assigned to him by Article I of the Order, comprise the area for the time being included in the several Unions named in the Schedule to that Order;

And whereas it is prescribed by Article II of the said Order that it shall be the duty of the said District Auditor to audit the Accounts of the Authorities and their Officers mentioned or referred to in paragraphs (1), (2), and (3) of that Article, as well as the Accounts of such of the said other Authorities whose Accounts are or may be by law subject to be audited by a District Auditor, and whose Districts or the areas of whose jurisdiction are for the time being partly situated within the said Audit District, as We might by Order under Seal thereafter prescribe;

And whereas the North Derbyshire Hospital Committee is an Authority whose Accounts are subject to be audited by a District Auditor, and the area of whose jurisdiction is partly situated within the said Audit District;

Now therefore, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by the Statutes in that behalf, We

hereby Order and Prescribe that it shall, until We otherwise prescribe, be the duty of the said Arthur George Chamberlin to audit the Accounts of the North Derbyshire Hospital Committee, and of their Officers in conformity with the provisions contained in the above-cited Order; and that for the purpose of such Audit the area of the jurisdiction of the said Hospital Committee shall be deemed to be within the Nottinghamshire Audit District.

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE.

(DATED 2ND JANUARY 1899.)

THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 and 1896, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Application of Swine-Fever (Movement) Order of 1898.

1. From and after the commencement of this Order, the Districts of the Local Authorities mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall be subject to the Swine-Fever (Movement) Order of 1898, and the provisions of such Order shall apply thereto accordingly:

Provided that any part of the said Districts which for the time being is declared by Special Order of the Board of Agriculture to be a Swine-Fever Infected Area shall not be subject to the Swine-Fever (Movement) Order of 1898.
