In the High Court of Justice.—Companies (Winding-up).

Mr. Justice Wright.
No. 00177 of 1896.

In the Matter of the Companies Acts 1862 to 1890 and in the Matter of Goodwins Jardine and Co. Limited.

By an Order made by Mr. Justice Wright in the above matters dated the 20th day of December 1898 upon the petition of the Industrial and General Trust Limited creditors of the above named Company it was ordered that the voluntary winding up of the said Company be continued but subject to the supervision of the Court and any of the proceedings under the said voluntary winding up might be adopted as the Court should think fit and it was ordered that James Watson Stewart the Liquidator in the voluntary winding up of the said Company should on the 16th February 1899 and every 3 months thereafter file with the Registrar Companies (Winding-up) a report in writing as to the position of and the progress made with the winding up of the said Company and with the realization of the assets thereof and as to any other matters connected with the winding up as the Court may from time to time direct. And it was ordered that no bills of costs charges or expenses or special remuneration of any Solicitor employed by the Liquidator of the said Company or any remuneration charges or expenses of such Liquidator or of any Manager Accountant Auctioneer Broker or other person be paid out of the assets of the said Company unless such costs, charges expenses, or remuneration shall have been taxed or allowed by the Registrar Companies (Winding up). And it was ordered that all such costs charges expenses and remuneration be taxed and ascertained accordingly. And it was ordered that the costs of the petitioners and of the creditors (including therein all costs that have been reserved and also the proper costs charges and expenses of examining witnesses in this matter) and the costs of the contributory of appearing on the 2nd November 1898 upon the said Petition be respectively taxed and paid out of the assets of the said Company. And it was ordered that the said Liquidator be at liberty to forthwith distribute the sum of £9,744 11s. 1d. by way of dividend among the creditors of the said Company. And the creditors contributories and Liquidator of the said Company and all other persons interested were to be at liberty to apply to the Court as there might be occasion. And the time within which the Order is to be advertised in the London Gazette is extended until the 3rd January 1899.—Dated the 2nd day of January 1899.
