## SWINE-FEVER INVECTED AREAS.

THE following Areas are now Areas Infected with Swine-Fever under the above-mentioned Acts:—

Bedfordshire and Northamptonshire.—An Area comprising the petty sessional division of Wellingborough, and the parishes of Raunds, and Hargrave, in the county of Northampton; and also comprising the parishes of Shelton, Dean, Yelden, Melchbourne, Knotting, Riseley, Wymington, Podington, Souldrop, Sharnbrook, Odell, Harrold, and the detached part of Bletsoe, in the county of Bedford (4 November, 1898).

Berkshire and Buckinghamshire.—An Area comprising the parishes of Bray, and Cookham, and the municipal borough of Maidenhead, in the county of Berks; and also comprising the petty sessional divisions of the Hundred of Stoke, the Hundred of Desborough (First Division), and the Hundred of Desborough (Second Division), and the parishes of Wooburn, Boveney, Burnham, Dorney, Farnham Royal, Hedgerley Dean, Hitcham, and Taplow, in the county of Buckingham, and also comprising the borough of Chepping (or High) Wycombe (10 February, 1898).

Cardiganshire.—An Area comprising the petty sessional division of Upper Geneur-glyn, in the county of Cardigan (28 November, 1898).

Carmarthenshire. — An Area comprising the parishes of Conwil-Elvet, Llanpumsaint, Llanlawddog, Abernant. Merthyr, Newchurch, and Abergwili, in the county of Carmarthen, and also comprising the borough of Carmarthen (5 November, 1898).

carnarvonshire.—An Area comprising the parishes of Pentir, Llanddeiniolen, Llanfair-is-gaer, No. 27043.

Llanrûg I.lanfaglan, Waenfawr, Llanberis, Llanwnda, Bettws Garmon, Llandwrog, Llanllyfni, and Clynnog, in the county of Carnarvon, and also comprising the borough of Carnarvon (25 March, 1898).

Denbighshire.—An Area comprising the petty sessional division of Isaled, and the parishes of Llangynhafal, Llanychan, and Llanynys Rural, in the county of Denbigh, and also comprising the borough of Denbigh (16 January, 1893).

Essex.—An Area in the county of Essex, comprising the petty sessional divisions of Beacontree, and Romford, except such portion of the parish of Cranham as is situate within the lastmentioned petty sessional division (2 December, 1898).

Kent.—An Area comprising the petty sessional division of Ramsgate together with the parish of Sarre and any other place which is included in the liberty of a Cinque Port, and is situate within or to the north of that division, the petty sessional division of Wingham (except the parishes of Bishopsbourne, Kingston, Barham, Womenswold, Denton, Wootton, Sibertswold, Coldred, Lydden, Temple Ewell, Whitfield, River, Poulton, Hougham-Without, Guston, East Langdon, West Cliffe, Oxney, and St. Margaret at Cliffe), and the boroughs of Margate, Ramsgate, and Sandwich (15 October, 1898).

Lincolnshire.—An Area in the Parts of Holland Division of Lincolnshire, comprising the petty sessional division of Elloe, and the parishes of Surfleet, Quadring, Donington, Bicker, Swineshead, Simon Weir, Wigtoft, Drainage Marsh, Gosberton, Sutterton, Algarkirk, and Fosdyke, and the lands common to the parishes of Swineshead and Wigtoft (8 November, 1898).

Middlesex.—An Area in the county of Middlesex
