may from time to time change wholly or in part such Duties or Districts ;

And whereas by an Order dated the 16th day of June, 1897, We, the Local Government Board, certified the appointment of the said Charles Hunton as a District Auditor, and directed that, unless We otherwise prescribed, it should be the duty of the said District Auditor to audit the Accounts of the County Councils of the several Administrative Counties named in Schedule A to that Order and the other Accounts referred to in Article I of such Order, including the Accounts of the Council of the Isles of Scilly, and of the Overseers of the Poor of the Parishes of Bryher, Saint Agnes, Saint Martin's, Saint Mary's and Tresco, which are included in the said Isles, so far as the same might relate to any period prior to the 1st day of April, 1897; and We further directed that the District in which the said Charles Hunton should act as Auditor, and which should be termed the "South Western Counties Audit District," should, for the performance of the duties assigned to him by Article I of the said Order, comprise the area for the time being included in the several Administrative Counties named in the said Schedule A and in the Isles of Scilly ;

And whereas by an Order dated the 16th day of March, 1898, we altered the said Order dated the 16th day of June, 1897, by the substitution in Article I thereof of the words "first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ninetyeight," for the words "first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven";

And whereas it is expedient that the said Order should be further altered as hereinafter mentioned:

Now therefore, in pursuance of the powers given to Us in that behalf, We hereby alter the said Order dated the sixteenth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven (as altered by the said Order dated the sixteenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight), by the substitution in Article I thereof of the words "first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine," for the words "first day of April, one thousand eight hundred 'and ninety-eight"; and We do hereby Order that the said Order as so altered shall have full force and effect as if the words hereby substituted therein had been originally contained in such Order.
