WILD BIRD (ENGLAND).
The Wild Birds Protection (County Borough of Brighton) Order, 1899.
Dated 6th October, 1899.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the Wild Birds Protection Acts, 1880 to 1896, and upon application by the Council of the County Borough of Brighton, I hereby make the following Order:—

I. This Order may be cited as the Wild Birds Protection (County Borough of Brighton) Order,

1899.

BIRDS. Clase-Time Extended.

II. The time during which the taking and killing of Wild Birds is prohibited shall be extended so as to be from the 1st day of March to the 31st day of August in each year, both days inclusive, except with respect to the following birds:—

Wild Swan, Wild Goose, Mallard, Widgeon, Teal and other Wild Duck, Woodcock, Snipe, Godwit, Sandpipers other than Redshank, Curlew, Whimbrel.

Additions to the Schedule of the Act of 1880.

III. The Wild Birds Protection Act, 1880, shall apply within the County Borough of Brighton to the following Wild Birds in the same manner as if they were included in the schedule to the Act:—

Wryneck, Swallow, Martin (both species), Swift, Bearded Tit, Red-backed Shrike, Kestrel, Hobby, Buzzard, Honey Buzzard, Osprey; Peregrine Falcon, Raven, Kentish Plover, Bustard, Black-headed Bunting, Corn Bunting, Yellow Hammer, Cirl Bunting, Reed Bunting, Snow Bunting, Flycatcher (both species), Landrail, Linnet, Merlin, Nuthatch, Redstart, Stonechat, Long-tailed Tit, Great Tit, Blue Tit, Coal Tit, Marsh Tit, Crested Tit, Wagtails (all species), Whitethroat, Lesser Whitethroat, Garden Warbler, Biackcap, Dartford Warbler, Reed Warbler, Sedge Warbler, Grasshopper Warbler, Chiffchaff, Willow Warbler, Wood Warbler, Wheatear, Whinchat, Fire-crested Wren, Golden-crested Wren, Tree Sparrow.
