THE Queen has been pleased to give and grant unto Joseph Ble-k, Esq., Her Majesty's Royal licence and authority that he may accept and wear the Cross of Officer of the Royal Order of the Saviour, conferred upon him by His Majesty the King of the Hellenes, in recognition of his services as Consul of Greece at Lisbon.

THE Queen has been pleased to give and grant unto Thomas Macleod, Esq., Director of the Maritime Company of Manila, Her Majesty's Royal licence and authority that he may accept and wear the Insignia of a Knight Grand Cross of the Royal Order of Isabella the Catholic, conferred upon him by Her Majesty the Queen Regent of Spain, in the name of His Majesty the King of Spain, in recognition of his services in

assisting the wounded and sick of the Spanish Army in the last Campaign in the Philippines.

THE Queen has been pleased to approve the appointment of Mr. James Pratt, of the Civil Service of India, to be a Judge of the High Court of Judicature at Fort William, in Bengal, in the place of Sir William Macpherson, retired.
