legally can or may be) as from the day aforesaid substituted so far as it relates to the said Archdeaconry of Winchester for the hereinbeforementioned Statutory Schedule of Rural Deaneries within the said diocese of Winchester as aforesaid and for the schedules referred to in the said Order of Your Majesty in Council dated the fourth day of February in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine as aforesaid and in the said Order of Your Majesty in Council dated the ninth day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two as aforesaid.

"And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other matter or thing with respect to the matters aforesaid or any of them under or by virtue of the said Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.
