In the High Court of Justice.—Companies
(Winding-up).
Mr. Justice Wright.
No. 00211 of 1900.

In the Matter of the Companies Acts, 1862 to 1893, and in the Matter of Healing and Co. Limited.

BY an Order made by Mr. Justice Wright in the above matters, dated the 9th day of August, 1900, on the petition of the said Company, whose registered office is at 18, Findockmews, Maida Vale, in the county of London, it was ordered that the voluntary winding up of the

said Healing and Co. Limited be continued, but subject to the supervision of the Court; and any of the proceedings under the said voluntary winding up might be adopted as the Court should think fit. And it was ordered that Alexander Phillips, the Liquidator appointed in the voluntary winding up of the said Company should every three months file with the Registrar Companies (Winding-up) a report in writing as to the position of and the progress made with the winding up of the said Company and with the realization of the assets thereof and as to any other matters connected with the winding up as the Court might from time
