In the High Court of Justice.—Companies (Winding-up). Mr. Justice Wright. No. 00211 of 1900.

In the Matter of the Companies Acts, 1862 to 1893, and in the Matter of Healing and Co. Limited.

B^Y an Order made by Mr. Justice Wright in the above matters, dated the 9th day of August, 1900, on the petition of the said Company, whose registered office is at 18, Pindockmews, Maida Vale, in the county of London, it was ordered that the voluntary winding up of the
