Composition to be paid as hereinafter mentioned on all provable debts, viz., the legal costs of the two Judgment Creditors by whom the debtor's effects had been seized in execution at the date of the Receiving Order to be paid in full, and 15s. in the pound, in two instalments of 10s. and 5s. respectively, payable in cash, to be paid on all provable debts. The first instalment of 10s. to be payable within 14 days after the approval of the Court of this Composition, and the second instalment at four months from the date of such approval. Payment of the Composition to be secured in the following manner, viz., by the deposit with the Official Receiver within seven days from the date of the approval of the Composition by the Court of a sum sufficient to pay said costs of Judgment Creditors and the first instalment, such deposit being guaranteed by a person or persons approved of by the Official Receiver, and the payment of the second instalment being secured by the guarantee of a person or persons to be approved by the Official Receiver and the Court.
