

GRESHAM ROAD, Staines.	Eight Carriages. At Gresham Road Staines, commencing on the North side of Gresham Road 23 yards from the South-west exit of the London and South-Western Railway Station, and extending along by the fence towards the Kingston Road as far as necessary; horses' heads Westwards.
PARK ROAD, West Norwood.	Six Carriages. On the South side of Park Road, West Norwood, commencing thirty-eight feet (38 ft.) from the kerb in Norwood Road and extending in an Easterly direction as far as necessary; horses' heads towards Norwood Road.
TEMPLETON PLACE, West Cromwell Road.	Ten Carriages. In centre of roadway at Templeton Place, commencing at the foot-crossing at West Cromwell Road and extending Southward as far as necessary; horses' heads North.
GROSVENOR ROAD, Ranelagh Road.	Three Carriages. On the South side of Grosvenor Road opposite Messrs. Simpson and Co.'s premises, corner of Ranelagh Road; horses' heads Westward.
ALDERMAN'S HILL, Southgate.	Three Carriages. On the East side of Alderman's Hill, Southgate, commencing 20 yards from the centre of Railway Bridge, Palmer's Green Railway Station, and extending alongside the kerb as far as necessary; horses' heads Northward.
GEORGE STREET, Marylebone.	Three Carriages. At George Street, Marylebone, commencing at South East corner of Manchester Street at rear of Hertford House and extending by kerb Eastward as far as necessary; horses' heads Westward.
SPRINGFIELD PARK CRESCENT, Catford.	Three Carriages. On the South side of Springfield Park Crescent, Catford, commencing at its junction with Rushey Green and extending as far as necessary; horses facing East.
KENSINGTON PARK ROAD, Ladbroke Road.	Twelve Carriages. In Kensington Park Road, at junction of Ladbroke Road, in centre of roadway, commencing at the North end of the Cabmen's Shelter and continuing Northward as far as necessary; horses' heads South.
RICHMOND LITTLE GREEN, Richmond.	Six Carriages. Along the foot-way on the South side of Richmond Little Green, opposite Richmond Theatre; horses' heads Eastwards.
HIGH STREET, East Ham.	Three Carriages. At the South-east side of High Street, East Ham, adjoining Railway Bridge; horses' heads North.
STATION ROAD, Sidcup.	One Carriage. On the West side of Station Road, Sidcup, extending along the Watercourse North of the Railway Arch as far as necessary.
HERBERT CRESCENT, Hans Crescent.	One Carriage. In the centre of Herbert Crescent, Chelsea, South of the lamp-post at the junction of Hans Crescent.
STATION ROAD, Sidcup.	Three Carriages. On the West side of Station Road, Sidcup, extending along the Watercourse North of the Railway Arch as far as necessary; horses' heads face Southwards.
LANGHAM STREET, Great Portland Street.	One Carriage. On the North side of Langham Street, by the South side of St. Paul's Church.
LEDBURY ROAD, Croydon.	Two Carriages. On the South side of Ledbury Road, Croydon, alongside the kerb by the dead wall of the Union Bank of London.
SEYMOUR STREET, Edgware Road.	Two Carriages. On the South side of Seymour Street, commencing at Edgware Road, and extending Eastwards as far as necessary; horses heads to the West.
STATION ROAD and CARGREEN ROAD. South Norwood.	Six Carriages. In two portions, viz.:— First portion.—Two Carriages in centre of Station Road, South Norwood, commencing South of the Underground Lavatories, and extending towards the Railway Station; horses' heads facing North. Second portion.—Four carriages on North side of Cargreen Road, commencing six yards from the junction of Station Road, and extending alongside the kerb as far as necessary; horses facing Station Road. The first portion to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.
