(1.) The area of Holborn Registration District shall be made identical with that of Holborn Poor Law Union (including Lincoln's-inn and Gray's-inn) as it will be constituted, under the provisions of the London Government Act, 1899, on and after the 25th of March, 1901;

(2.) The area lying outside the proposed new boundary of the Union and of Lincoln's-inn and Gray's-inn, coloured green and numbered 5 on the official map of the Metropolitan Borough of Holborn, together with the part of Furnival's-inn added to the Parish of St. Andrew, Holborn, below the Bars, and the part of St. Sepulchre (Middlesex) Parish added to St. Sepulchre, Newgate-street, Parish; and the areas coloured green and numbered 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 19, and 21 on the official map of the Metropolitan Borough of Finsbury, together with the detached part of St. James and St. John, Clerkenwell Parish, added to Hornsey Parish, shall cease to form part of Holborn Registration District;
