High Court of Justice in Bankruptcy	803 of 1900	Jan. 22, 1901	<p><i>The following Amended Notice is substituted for that published in the London Gazette of the 5th February, 1901.</i></p> <p>That Mr. George Stimpson the younger, of 86, Woburn-square, in the county of London, in consideration of the acceptance and approval of this Scheme of Arrangement, agrees to provide and deposit within 14 days after the acceptance of this Scheme by the creditors, with Mr. Edward Cecil Moore, as Trustee of this Scheme, a sum of money sufficient, with the assets already in the hands of Mr. Edward Cecil Moore, as the Trustee in this Bankruptcy, to pay to the unsecured creditors under this Bankruptcy, and to the partly secured creditors (after allowing the value of their securities), the sum of 10s. in the pound upon the amount of the debts provable under the Bankruptcy, the money so deposited, together with the said assets, to be administered and distributed by Mr. Edward Cecil Moore, as Trustee of this Scheme in like manner, and with like provisions, powers, and duties, and subject to the like conditions in all respects as though the same formed the bankrupt's estate, divisible amongst the creditors. Preferential debts and all proper costs, charges, expenses, fees and percentages to be secured and paid in like manner. That should the amount deposited by the said George Stimpson the younger exceed the amounts of the payments to be made thereout under this Scheme, the surplus shall be returned to the said George Stimpson the younger.
