

AT the Court at *Saint James's*, the 25th day of *March*, 1901.

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have in pursuance of the Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter ninety-four duly prepared and laid before His Majesty in Council a scheme or representation bearing date the twenty-eighth day of February, in the year one thousand nine hundred and one, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

“WE the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England acting under the provisions of the Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria chapter ninety-four have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following scheme or representation for altering the boundaries of the new parish of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill of the new parish of Saint Mary Crumpsall and of the new parish of Saint Thomas Lower Crumpsall all within the original limits of the parish of Manchester and in the county of Lancaster, and in the diocese of Manchester.

“Whereas by the authority of an Order of Her said late Majesty in Council bearing date the twenty-fourth day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six and published in the London Gazette upon the first day of July following a part of the said parish of Manchester was disannexed therefrom and was constituted and annexed as a district for spiritual purposes to the consecrated church of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill situate within the limits of the said parish of Manchester and the said district was named ‘The District of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill.’

“And whereas the said District of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill has become a new parish of the character contemplated by the Act of the sixth and seventh years of Her said late Majesty chapter thirty-seven by the Act of the nineteenth and twentieth years of Her said late Majesty chapter one hundred and four and by the said above-mentioned Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Her said late Majesty chapter ninety-four.

“And whereas by the authority of another Order of Her said late Majesty in Council bearing date the twenty-sixth day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty and published in the London Gazette on the thirtieth day of the same month certain parts of the said new parish of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill and of the new parish of Saint Luke Cheetham Hill also within the original limits of the parish of Manchester aforesaid were set out and constituted for and annexed as a district for spiritual purposes to the consecrated church of Saint Mary at Crumpsall situate within the original limits of the said parish of Manchester and the same district was named ‘The District of Saint Mary Crumpsall.’

“And whereas the said District of Saint Mary Crumpsall has also become a new parish of the character contemplated as aforesaid.

“And whereas by the authority of another Order of Her said late Majesty in Council bearing date the tenth day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four and published in the London Gazette on the fourteenth day of the same month certain parts of the said new parish of Saint Luke Cheetham Hill and of the said new parish of Saint Mary Crumpsall were set out and constituted for, and annexed as a district for spiritual purposes to the consecrated church of

Saint Thomas situate at Lower Crumpsall within the original limits of the parish of Manchester aforesaid, and the said district was named ‘The District of Saint Thomas Lower Crumpsall.’

“And whereas the said district of Saint Thomas Lower Crumpsall has also become a new parish of the character contemplated as aforesaid.

“And whereas it has been represented to us and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the said new parish of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill and of the said new parish of Saint Mary Crumpsall and of the said new parish of Saint Thomas Lower Crumpsall should be altered in the manner hereinafter mentioned.

“Now therefore with the consent of the Right Reverend James Bishop of the said diocese of Manchester (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this scheme or representation) we the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners humbly represent recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this scheme or representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the boundaries of the said new parish of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill and of the said new parish of Saint Mary Crumpsall shall be altered so that all those two portions of the said new parish of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill which are described in the first schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto appended and are thereon coloured green shall be dissevered from such lastly-named new parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said new parish of Saint Mary Crumpsall.

“And further that in like manner the boundaries of the said new parish of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill and of the said new parish of Saint Thomas Lower Crumpsall shall be altered so that all that portion of the said new parish of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill which is described in the second schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the said map or plan hereunto appended and is thereon coloured pink shall be dissevered from the same new parish of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said new parish of Saint Thomas Lower Crumpsall.

“And we further represent recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing recommending or proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or any of them in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.

“The SCHEDULES to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

“The FIRST SCHEDULE.

“The territory to be dissevered from the new parish of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill in the county of Lancaster, and in the diocese of Manchester and to be annexed to the new parish of Saint Mary Crumpsall, in the same county and diocese being:—

“I. All that portion of the said new parish of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill which is bounded upon the north-east and upon the north-west by the said new parish of Saint Mary Crumpsall and upon the remaining sides that is to say upon the south-west, upon the south and upon the south-east by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said new parish of Saint Mary Crumpsall from the new parish of Saint Mark Cheetham Hill aforesaid at the junction of Tyson-street with Cheetham Hill-road and extending thence south-eastward along
