In the High Court of Justice.—Chancery Division.
Mr. Justice Byrne.

In the Matter of the China and Japan Telephone Company Limited, and in the Matter of the Companies (Memorandum of Association) Act, 1890.

NOTICE is hereby given, that a petition presented to the High Court of Justice (Chancery Division), on the 12th day of April, 1901, for confirming a Special Resolution passed on the 22nd day of January, 1901, and confirmed on the 13th day of February, 1901: That the provisions of the Memorandum of Association of the Company with respect to its objects be altered as follows, that is to say:—1. By inserting in paragraph 1 of the Company's Memorandum of

Association after the word "telephone" the words "and electric." 2. By striking out in paragraph (3) (b) of the Company's Memorandum of Association all words from the beginning down to and inclusive of the word "generally" in line 3 thereof and substituting therefor the words "To carry on in the countries and places aforesaid and in any other town settlement or dependency now or hereafter forming or to form geographically or politically part of China or Japan and elsewhere not only the said businesses or any of them but also the business of an electric light and power Company in all its branches and the business of electricians mechanical engineers and manufacturers of and dealers in all apparatus and things required for or capable of being used in connection with the generation distribution supply
