..	6TH IMPERIAL BUSHMEN. Corporal W. Fyfe..	Operations near Potchefstroom, as my head conductor, has done excellent work throughout, and on 24th March, 1901, when the convoy was attacked was of the greatest assistance. ..	14TH BATTERY, ROYAL FIELD ARTILLERY. Gunner Keiller ..	At Botha's Drift, Orange River, 10th March, 1901, owing to strong current, three leading horses were washed off their legs, and the guns stuck. Gunner Keiller volunteered to take out a rope and on its breaking went out a second time. He afterwards manned a wheel with Lieutenant Holford and kept that Officer up when he was swept away by the current. The horses and guns were eventually saved, and chiefly by the exertions of Lieutenant Holford and Gunner Keiller.	General Forestier-Walker's special despatch, 9th April, 1901.
