I.—VOLUNTEER ARTILLERY CORPS.

During 2nd year‡ and each subsequent year	Nil ...	15 attendances* ; or 24 attendances,* including gun practice, if the corps or Volunteer is exempt from attending camp	As above ...	As above

NOTE.—Staff sergeants, bandmen, and trumpeters will be reckoned as efficient provided they attend the prescribed number of regimental parades or the annual camp and inspection, as the case may be.
