WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction of seven hundred pounds sterling which has been paid to us in favour of the rectory of Egremont, in the county of Cumberland, and in the diocese of Carlisle, and in respect of which we have agreed to pay to the Incumbent of the same rectory, and to his successors, a yearly sum of twenty-one pounds, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, grant out of our common fund to the said rectory of Egremont, to meet such benefaction, one other capital sum of seven hundred pounds, in respect of which, so long as the same capital sum or any part thereof shall remain in our hands, there shall be paid by us to the Incumbent for the time being of the said rectory, one other yearly sum of twenty-one pounds, or such part thereof as shall be proportionate to any balance of the same capital sum which shall so remain in our hands; the above-mentioned yearly payments to commence as from the twenty-third day of May, in the year one thousand nine hundred and two, and to be receivable in equal quarterly portions on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August, and the first day of November in each and every year.
