Notice is hereby given, that in pursuance of the provisions of the twenty-first section of an Act passed in the thirty-eighth year of the reign of Her late Majesty, intituled "The Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874," I, Reginald MacLeod, C.B., Registrar-General of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in England, have, with the sanction of the Local Government Board, ordered and declared that on and after the first day of July next, in order that Hartley Wintney and Basingstoke Registration Districts may again be made co-extensive with Hartley Wintney and Basingstoke Poor Law Unions, as altered by the Local Government Board Order, No. 43,702, dated the 13th March, 1902, the formerly detached part of Mattingley Civil Parish, which by the operation of that Order was on April 1st added to Upton Grey Civil Parish, shall be transferred from Odiham Sub-District of Hartley Wintney Registration District to Dummer Sub-District of Basingstoke Registration District.—Witness my hand this 9th day of June, 1902.

AXMINSTER AND LYME REGIS LIGHT RAILWAY COMPANY.

(Railway Companies Powers Act, 1864; Railways (Powers and Construction) Act, 1864, Amendment Act, 1870; Authority to raise Additional Capital.)

FLEETWOOD URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL (Construction of New Outfall and other Sewers and Pumping Station; acquisition of Lands, Compulsorily or by Agreement; Easements over or under Lands; Additional Lands for Pumping Station; further Borrowing Powers for Sewage Purposes; Incorporation and Amendment of Acts.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Urban District Council of Fleetwood, in the county of Lancaster (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), intend to apply to Parliament for leave to introduce a Bill in the present Session for the following or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

1. To authorize the Council to make and maintain in the Urban District of Fleetwood, in the county of Lancaster, the following works or some or one of them, with all necessary and proper tanks, storage and subsidiary sewers, outfalls, works and conveniences (that is to say):—

- (1.) An outfall sewer (No. 1) commencing in Dock-street by a junction with the existing sewer of the Council at the intersection of that street with Albert-street, thence passing under and along Dock-street, Lower Dock-street, Cop-lane, Styant-street, West-street, Radcliffe-road, Belmont-road, Park-avenue, thence through and under lands belonging to and occupied by the Fleetwood Estate Limited, and terminating on the foreshore at a point 403 yards from the western boundary of the field numbered 21 on the 2500 inch Ordnance Map (first edition, 1891) of the parish and township of Fleetwood.
 - (2.) An outfall sewer (No. 2) commencing at or in the pumping station hereinafter described, and terminating on the shore or bed of the sea at a point 657 yards or thereabouts measured in a north-westerly direction from Rossall Land Mark.
 - (3.) An outfall sewer (No. 3) commencing by a junction with outfall sewer No. 1 hereinafter described, in the said field No. 21 on the 2500 inch Ordnance Map of the said parish, and terminating in the pumping station hereinafter described.
 - (4.) A pumping station with an approach thereto to be situate in the said field numbered 21 on the 2500 inch Ordnance Map of the said parish, and on land hereinafter described, and thereafter maintain and use and manage all necessary and proper erections, appliances, tanks, wells, basins, pumping and other engines, mains, buildings, machinery, apparatus, works, and conveniences for receiving, pumping, and conveying the sewage of the district.
2. To authorize the Council, in connection with the said intended works before described, to make and maintain all necessary approaches, retaining
