The payment in full of all fees and percentages payable to the Board of Trade and the Official Receiver, and of all the proper costs, charges, and expenses of and incidental to the proceedings in bankruptcy against me and this proposal, including the Trustee's remuneration, and the payment of the costs of all other persons so far as they are incidental to the bankruptcy proceedings and this proposal and shall be allowed by the Court. 2. The payment in full of all debts directed by the Bankruptcy Acts, 1883 and 1890, and the preferential payments in Bankruptcy Act, 1883, to be paid in priority to other debts. 3. The payment to all unsecured creditors in respect of all debts provable in the bankruptcy proceedings, and in full satisfaction and discharge of the same, a Composition of 7s. 6d. in the pound payable in cash as soon as may be after the approval by the Court of this proposal. 4. The several amounts payable under clauses 1 and 2 of this proposal and of the said Composition shall be paid by the Official Receiver, as Trustee, out of the moneys which shall be in his hands as proceeds realized from the sale, getting in, or conversion of any part of debtor's estate. But if the same are likely to prove insufficient for such purposes, the payment of the several amounts and of the Composition shall be fully secured by the deposit with the Official Receiver of such further sum of money as in his sole judgment may be necessary for the payment thereof, such deposit to be made not later than the day before the hearing of the application to the Court to approve of this proposal.
