EXPLOSIVES ACT, 1875.

In virtue of the powers conferred on me by section 53 of the Explosives Act, 1875, I, the Right Honourable Aretas Akers-Douglas, being one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, hereby appoint Sergeant William John McBride, of the Royal Irish Constabulary, an Inspector for Ireland under the said Act, and hereby direct him to exercise only such powers, and to perform such duties under the said Act, as I shall from time to time assign to him.
