

THE HOMAGE.

The Exhortation being ended, His Majesty delivered the Sceptre with the Cross to the nobleman who had first borne it, to hold the same on His Right Hand, and the Sceptre with the Dove to the nobleman who had first borne it, to hold the same on His Left Hand during the Homage.
