

of Saint Mary Battersea and Wandsworth in the county of London and the reconstruction of Rosemary Branch-bridge (Regent's Canal) in the Parishes of Saint John Hackney and Saint Leonard Shoreditch and Saint Mary Islington respectively described in and authorized by that Act.

Street Markets.

To empower the Councils of Metropolitan Boroughs in which commodities are offered for sale in or upon the roadway or footway of any street or public place to provide accommodation for the sale of such commodities and to erect buildings or shelters and appropriate take on lease or purchase lands for that purpose.

To empower such Councils to prescribe the terms and regulations upon and subject to which such buildings or shelters may be used and subject thereto to provide that such buildings or shelters shall be open for public use as retail markets.

To provide for the approval of such regulations by the proper authority.

Removal and disposal of Dead Horses.

To prohibit the use of any premises within the county of London for the purpose of receiving or keeping horses for slaughter or the carcasses of dead horses unless such premises are licensed by the Council to be used for that purpose and to enable the Council to make bye-laws with respect to the said matters.

To make provisions relating to the granting of and otherwise with respect to licenses in respect of such premises;

To empower the Council to make enforce vary and amend bye-laws with respect to the mode of conveying the carcasses of dead horses through and along public streets in the County.

To provide for the confirmation approval and publication of such bye-laws and to make other provisions incidental thereto or to any of the matters aforesaid.

To prescribe penalties for the breach of or offences against any such provision or bye-law and if thought fit to empower the Councils of Metropolitan Boroughs to take proceedings for enforcing such bye-laws or any of them.

Alteration of Method of Testing Gas of South Metropolitan Gas Company.

To alter the existing method employed by the South Metropolitan Gas Company of testing and recording the illuminating power of gas and to provide by repealing Section 6 of "the South Metropolitan Gas Act 1900" or by express enactment or by both of such means that the method of testing and recording such illuminating power shall be such as may from time to time be prescribed by the gas referees appointed by the Board of Trade.

Drainage of Upper Norwood.

To empower the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Croydon acting by the Council of that Borough (in this Notice referred to as "the Croydon Council") to discharge sewage drainage and surface water from Upper Norwood into the sewers of the Council and to provide for the payment to the Council by the Croydon Council of such sum or sums as the Bill may prescribe.

To make provision for the recovery of any such sums in the payment of which default may be made.

To empower the Council in case of default for a period of six months or such other period as the Bill may prescribe in payment of any such sums to appoint persons to levy on the area from which such sewage drainage and surface water may be discharged (in this

Notice referred to as "the said area") the unpaid amount and to confer upon such persons the powers remedies and privileges of any person duly appointed for a like purpose by the Croydon Council.

To provide for the furnishing from time to time to the Council by the Croydon Council of a copy of the Valuation List in force for the purpose of the rate for the relief of the poor within the said area.

To confer powers upon the Council to examine the valuation of the property within the said area.

To empower the Council to enter upon and inspect any sewage works sewers and drains within the said area for the purpose of ascertaining whether any breach of the provisions of the intended Act is being committed and for that purpose to break up or open and reinstate any street within the said area.

To provide for the settlement of differences as to the matters aforesaid between the Council and the Croydon Council.

To confirm and give effect to any Agreement or Agreements between the Council and the Croydon Council with respect to the matters aforesaid or any of them.

Powers of Metropolitan Borough Councils in connection with supply of Electric Energy.

To empower the Councils of Metropolitan Boroughs being authorized to supply and supplying electricity to expend moneys upon the wiring and fitting and supplying with wires fittings machinery and apparatus the premises of any of their consumers or prospective consumers of electric energy and to enter into and carry into effect agreements and arrangements with respect thereto and to make such charges therefor whether directly or otherwise as they may think fit.

To empower the Councils of such Metropolitan Boroughs or any of them to borrow in the same manner and subject to the same conditions as if such expenditure were for the purposes of "the Electric Lighting Acts 1882 and 1888" and upon such terms and conditions as to repayment and otherwise as may be specified in the Bill such sums of money as may be required by such Councils for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned.

Maintenance of Public Clocks by Metropolitan Borough Councils.

To empower the Councils of Metropolitan Boroughs or any of them to expend moneys upon the erection maintenance repair illumination and winding of clocks in or upon public places within their respective Boroughs and to confer upon such Councils such other powers in connection with the said matters as may be defined by the Bill.

To empower the said Councils to charge moneys so expended by them upon the general rate leviable by them within their respective Boroughs or to make such other provisions for defraying expenses incurred in the exercise of such powers as the intended Act may prescribe.

Financial and Miscellaneous.

To repeal or amend section 50 of "The London County Council (Improvements) Act 1900" and to provide that there shall be charged to and deemed to be part of the costs and expenses of the Thames Embankment Extension and Improvements at Westminster authorized by the said Act and shall be applied as in the said Section mentioned such a sum as the Council shall determine or as may be pre-
