Incumbent for the time being of the said particular district of Saint Mary and All Saints; Palfrey, Walsall. Provided always, that nothing herein contained shall be construed as expressing any intention on the part of the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England to concur in or approve the taking of any fee for the performance of the said office of baptism or for the registration thereof.
