

BIRDS.

Close Time extended.

II. The time during which the killing or taking of Wild Birds is prohibited by the Act of 1880, shall be extended throughout the County of Surrey so as to be between the last day of January and the first day of September in any year.

Additions to the Schedule of the Act of 1880.

III. The Wild Birds Protection Act, 1880, shall apply within so much of the County of Surrey as is *within* the Metropolitan Police District to the following species of Wild Birds in the same manner as if those species were included in the schedule to the Act:—

Blackheaded Bunting, Cirl Bunting, Reed Bunting, Great Bustard, Little Bustard, Buzzard, Honey Buzzard, Chiffchaff, Crossbill, Pied Flycatcher, Spotted Flycatcher, Hedgessparrow, Hen Harrier, Hobby, Kestrel, Kite, Landrail (or Corn-crake), Linnnet, Magpie, House Martin, Sand Martin, Merlin, Moorhen, Nutcracker, Nuthatch, Osprey, Peregrine Falcon, Meadow Pipit, Tree Pipit, Raven, Redbreast or Robin, Mealy Redpole, Lesser Redpole, Redstart, Rose-coloured Pastor, Shrike, Siskin, Stonechat, Swallow, Swift, Bearded Tit, Coal Tit, Crested Tit, Long-tailed Tit, Marsh Tit, Tree Creeper, Turtle Dove, Grey Wagtail, Pied Wagtail, White Wagtail, Yellow Wagtail, Blackcap Warbler, Dartford Warbler, Garden Warbler, Grasshopper Warbler, Reed Warbler, Sedge Warbler, Willow Warbler, Wood Warbler, Water Rail, Wheatear, Whinchat, Whitethroat, Lesser Whitethroat, Common Wren, Fire-crested Wren, Golden-crested Wren, Wryneck.

IV. The Wild Birds Protection Act, 1880, shall apply within so much of the County of Surrey as is *without* the Metropolitan Police District to the following species of Wild Birds in the same manner as if those species were included in the schedule to the Act:—

Certain Birds protected during the whole of the Year.

V. During the period between the 31st day of August in any year and the 1st day of February following, the killing or taking of the following species of Wild Birds is prohibited throughout the County of Surrey:—

Avocet, Bee-Eater, Common Bittern, Little Bittern, Great Bustard, Little Bustard, Buzzard, Honey Buzzard, Chiffchaff, Crossbill, Pied Flycatcher, Spotted Flycatcher, Goldfinch, Great Crested Grebe, Gull (except Great Black-backed Gull), Hobby, Hoopoe, Kestrel, Kingfisher, Kite,

Linnnet, House Martin, Sand Martin, Merlin, Nightingale, Nightjar, Nutcracker, Nuthatch, Oriole, Osprey, Owl, Raven, Redbreast or Robin, Mealy Redpole, Lesser Redpole, Redstart, Roller, Rose-coloured Pastor, Siskin, Spoonbill, Stonechat, Stone Curlew (Great Plover or Thick-knee), Swallow, Swift, Coal Tit, Crested Tit, Long-tailed Tit, Marsh Tit, Grey Wagtail, Pied Wagtail, White Wagtail, Yellow Wagtail, Blackcap Warbler, Dartford Warbler, Garden Warbler, Grasshopper Warbler, Reed Warbler, Sedge Warbler, Willow Warbler, Wood Warbler, Wheatear, Whinchat, Whitethroat, Lesser Whitethroat, Green Woodpecker (or Yaffle), Great Spotted Woodpecker, Lesser Spotted Woodpecker, Common Wren, Fire-crested Wren, Golden-crested Wren, Wryneck.

All Birds protected on Sundays except in certain Parishes.

VI. During the period between the 31st day of August in any year and the 1st day of February following the killing or taking of Wild Birds on Sundays is prohibited throughout the County of Surrey, except in the undermentioned parishes:—

Bookham Little, Burstow, Chessington, Chobham, Elstead, Farnham, Puttenham, Reigate, Stoke-next-Guildford, Wallington, and Walton-on-Thames.

EGGS.

Certain Eggs protected in such part of the County as is within the Metropolitan Police District.

VII. The taking or destroying of the Eggs of the following species of Wild Birds is prohibited throughout such part of the County of Surrey as is *within* the Metropolitan Police District:—

American Quail, Bittern, Black-headed Bunting, Cirl Bunting, Reed Bunting, Buzzard, Honey Buzzard, Chiffchaff, Coot, Cuckoo, Pied Flycatcher, Spotted Flycatcher, Goldfinch, Great Crested Grebe, Greenshank, Hawfinch, Heron, Hobby, Hoopoe, Kestrel, Kingfisher, Landrail (or Corn-crake), Lark, Linnnet, House Martin, Sand Martin, Merlin, Magpie, Nightingale, Nightjar, Nuthatch, Oriole, Osprey, Owl (all species), Redshank, Redstart, Roller, Rose-coloured Pastor, Ruff (or Reeve), Shrike, Snipe, Starling, Stonechat, Stone Curlew (Great Plover or Thick-knee), Swallow, Swift, Bearded Tit, Crested Tit, Long-tailed Tit, Marsh Tit, Grey Wagtail, Pied Wagtail, White Wagtail, Yellow Wagtail, Blackcap Warbler, Dartford Warbler, Garden Warbler, Grasshopper Warbler, Reed Warbler, Sedge Warbler, Willow Warbler, Wood Warbler, Wheatear, Whinchat, Whitethroat, Lesser Whitethroat, Woodcock, Woodpecker, Common Wren, Fire-crested Wren, Golden-crested Wren, Wryneck.

Certain Eggs protected in such part of the County as is without the Metropolitan Police District.

VIII. The taking or destroying of the Eggs of the following species of Wild Birds is prohibited throughout such part of the County of Surrey as is *without* the Metropolitan Police District:—

American Quail, Bittern, Buzzard, Honey Buzzard, Pied Flycatcher, Goldfinch, Great Crested Grebe, Greenshank, Heron, Hobby, Hoopoe, Kingfisher, Landrail (or Corn-crake), Merlin, Nuthatch, Oriole, Osprey, Owl, Redshank, Roller, Rose-coloured Pastor, Ruff (or Reeve), Snipe, Stone Curlew (Great Plover or Thick-knee), Bearded Tit, Crested Tit, Marsh Tit, Dartford Warbler, Woodcock, Woodlark, Green
