thence by a vertical line to the centre of Parklane thence in a westerly direction along the centre of Park-lane to a point in the centre of High-street thence in a northerly direction along the centre of High-street to a point opposite the centre of Jackson-street thence to and along the centre of Jackson-street to the boundary of the North Ward thence in a northerly direction along the boundary of the said North Ward to the point of commencement aforesaid.

North-West Ward.

The North-West Ward shall comprise so much of the borough of Gateshead as is contained within an imaginary line commencing at a point in the River Tyne opposite the centre of the River Team at the north-west corner of the borough boundary thence in an easterly direction along the said boundary to its junction with the North Ward at a point in the River Tyne beneath the centre of the Redheugh Bridge thence in a southerly direction along the boundary of the North Ward to a point under the centre of the bridge over the North Eastern Railway in Redheugh Bridge-road thence by a vertical line to the centre of the said railway thence in a southwesterly direction along the centre of that railway to a point under the centre of the railway bridge across Lobley Hill-road thence by vertical line to the centre of Lobley Hill-road thence in a westerly direction along the centre of that road to a point under the centre of the bridge that carries the roadway across the River Team at the borough boundary thence by a vertical line to the centre of the River Team thence in a north-westerly direction along the borough boundary to the point of commencement aforesaid.

Central Ward.

The Central Ward shall comprise so much of the borough of Gateshead as is contained within an imaginary line commencing from a point in the boundary of the North Ward opposite the centre of Bank-street thence in an easterly direction along the boundary of the North Ward to a point in the boundary of the North Ward opposite the centre of West-street thence in a southerly direction along the centre of High West-street to a point opposite the centre of Bewick-road thence to and along the centre of Bewick-road to a point opposite to and in a direct line with the centre of Saint Cuthbert'splace thence to and along the centre of Saint Cuthbert's-place and the footpath that passes along the east side of West View to a point in Bensham-road opposite the centre of the said footpath thence in a north-easterly direction along the centre of Bensham-road to the point of commencement aforesaid.

East Central Ward.

The East Central Ward shall comprise so much of the borough of Gateshead as is contained within an imaginary line commencing from a point in the boundary of the Central Ward opposite the centre of Bensham-road thence in an easterly and south-easterly direction along the boundary of the North-East Ward to a point in the centre of the Newcastle and Sunderland Railway opposite to and in a direct line with the centre of Chaucer-street thence along the centre of Chaucer-street to a point in the centre of Sunderland-road thence in an easterly direction along the centre of Sunderland-road to a point opposite the centre of Wordsworth-street thence to and along the centre of Wordsworth-street and Cemetery-road to a point in the centre of High-street opposite the centre of Camilla-street thence to and along the centre of Camilla-street to a point in the centre of High West-street thence in a northerly direction along the boundary of the Central Ward to the point of commencement aforesaid.

South Central Ward.

The South Central Ward shall comprise so much of the borough of Gateshead as is contained within an imaginary line commencing from a point in the boundary of the Central Ward opposite the centre of Coatsworth-road thence in an easterly southerly and easterly direction along the boundaries of the Central and East Central Wards to a point in the centre of High-street opposite the centre of Camilla-street thence in a southerly direction along the centre of the Old Durham-road to a point opposite to the western wall of the Sheriff Hill Pottery thence in a westerly direction to the boundary between two fields numbered respectively 454 and 455 on the 1 scale Ordnance Map thence in a southerly direction to the northern boundary wall of Musgrave House thence in a westerly direction along the said boundary wall to a point in the centre of the Durham-road opposite the said boundary wall thence in a northerly direction along the centre of Durham-road to a point opposite the northern boundary of Heathfield House thence in a westerly direction along the said northern boundary of Heathfield House to a point in the centre of East Park-road, thence in a northerly direction along the centre of East Parkroad to a point opposite the centre of Saltwell View thence to and along Saltwell View to a point opposite the centre of Brinkburn-avenue thence to and along the centre of Brinkburn-avenue and Coatsworth-road to the point of commencement aforesaid.

West Central Ward.

The West Central Ward shall comprise so much of the borough of Gateshead as is contained within an imaginary line commencing from a point in the boundary of the North-West Ward in the centre of Lobley Hill-road immediately below the centre of the Team Valley Railway Bridge thence by a vertical line to the said Team Valley Railway thence in a north-easterly direction along the boundary of the North-West Ward to the boundary of the North Ward thence in a southerly direction along the boundary of the North Ward to the boundary of the Central Ward thence in a westerly southerly and easterly direction along the boundary of the Central Ward to the boundary of the South Central Ward to a point in the centre of Bewick-road opposite the centre of Coatsworth-road thence, in a southerly direction along the boundary of the South Central Ward to a point opposite the centre of Whitehall-road thence to and along the centre of Vernon-gardens and Whitehall-road West to a point in the centre of Saltwell-road thence along the centre of Saltwell-road in a north-westerly direction to a point in the centre of Lobley Hill-road opposite the centre of Saltwell-road thence in a westerly direction along the centre of Lobley Hill-road to the point of commencement aforesaid.

East Ward.

The East Ward shall comprise so much of the borough of Gateshead as is contained within an imaginary line commencing at a point in the boundary of the South Central Ward opposite the centre of Camilla-street thence in an easterly and north-easterly direction along the boundary of the East Central Ward to the boundary of the North-East Ward thence in a south-easterly direction along the boundary of the North-East Ward to the borough boundary thence in a southerly direction along the said boundary to the centre of an occupation read leading to Carr's Hill-
