such duly gazetted Order the cures of Saint James Hope Saint John the Evangelist James Hope Saint John the Evangelist Pendlebury and Saint Luke Weaste shall be transferred from the said Rural Deanery of Eccles and shall become and be part of the said Rural Deanery of Salford and the said Rural Deanery of Eccles and the said Rural Deanery of Salford shall respectively comprise and consist of the parishes cures and churches the names of which are set down in numbered order under the name of such Rural Deaneries respectively in the Schedule to this scheme annexed and each of the said parishes or cures or churches shall belong to and be and form part of the Rural Deanery and Archdeaconry under the names of which it is set down as aforesaid and shall be subject to the jurisdiction and authority of the Rural Dean of the Rural Deanery and of the Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry under which it is so set down as aforesaid and shall not belong to or be a part of any other Rural Deanery or Archdeaconry nor be subject to the jurisdiction and authority of any other Rural Dean or Archdeacon.

"And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other matter or thing with respect to the matters aforesaid or any of them by virtue of the said Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.
