"CONSENTS.

"The Right Honourable Hardinge Stanley Earl of Halsbury, the patron in right of his office of Lord Chancellor or person entitled to present to the benefice of Bradpole in the county of Dorset and diocese of Salisbury in case the same were now vacant. The Reverend Henry Cromwell Beckwith Field Incumbent of the same benefice. The Right Reverend John Bishop of Salisbury the patron in right of his said Bishoprick or person entitled to present to the benefice of Bridport in the said county and diocese if the same were now vacant and Henry Richard William Farrer, Incumbent of the same benefice.

"Do hereby respectively signify to your Grace our several consents to the scheme above proposed and set forth and to every matter and thing therein contained.

"In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands this twenty-fourth day of March one thousand nine hundred and three.

And whereas the said scheme hath been transmitted by the said Bishop to the said Archbishop for his consideration.

And whereas the said Archbishop being satisfied with the said scheme, hath certified the same and the consents aforesaid to His Majesty in Council by his report dated the twenty-seventh of May, one thousand nine hundred and three, which said report is in the words and figures following:—

"We the undersigned Randall Thomas Archbishop of the Province of Caunterbury do hereby report to Your Majesty in Council:—

"That the Right Reverend John Bishop of Salisbury has represented unto us (amongst other things):—

"That there are in the county of Dorset and his diocese of Salisbury the benefice (being a vicarage) of Bradpole; and the benefice (being a vicarage) of Bridport.

"That it appears to the said Lord Bishop that a certain district of the said parish of Bradpole known as Saint Andrew Bradpole, the boundaries whereof are more particularly described in his Lordship's representation hereunto annexed may

be advantageously separated from the said parish of Bradpole and annexed to the said contiguous parish of Bridport for ecclesiastical purposes only under the provisions of the Pluralities Act 1838.

"That pursuant to the directions contained in the said Act the said Lord Bishop has drawn up a scheme in writing describing the mode in which it appears to him that the proposed alteration may best be effected and how the changes consequent upon such alteration in respect of ecclesiastical jurisdiction, glebe lands, tithes, rent charges, and other ecclesiastical dues, rates, and payments and in respect to patronage and rights to pews may be made with justice to all parties interested, which scheme together with the consents thereto in writing of the Right Honourable Hardinge Stanley Earl of Halsbury being the patron in right of his office of Lord Chancellor or person entitled to present to the said benefice of Bradpole in case the same were now vacant, the Reverend Henry Cromwell Beckwith Field the present Incumbent of the same benefice, the Right Reverend John Bishop of Salisbury the patron in right of his Bishoprick or person entitled to present to the said benefice of Bridport in case the same were now vacant and the Reverend Henry Richard William Farrer the present Incumbent of the same benefice has been transmitted to us by the said Lord Bishop for our consideration.

"The representation and scheme of the said Lord Bishop and the consents above referred to are hereunto annexed.

"And we the said Archbishop being on full consideration and enquiry satisfied with the said scheme do hereby pursuant to the said Pluralities Act 1838 certify the same and such consents as aforesaid to Your Majesty in Council to the intent that Your Majesty in Council may in case Your Majesty in Council shall think fit so to do make and issue an Order for carrying the said scheme into effect.

Now, therefore, His Majesty in Council, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased to order, as it is hereby ordered, that the said scheme be carried into effect.
