By virtue of an Act passed in the twenty-second year of the reign of Her Most Gracious Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled "An Act to extend the Act of the twenty-fourth year of King George the Third, chapter twenty-six, for issuing Writs during any Recess of the House of Commons, whether by Prorogation or Adjournment," and of an Act passed in the twenty-sixth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled "An Act to further limit and define the time for proceeding to Election during the Recess."

I DO hereby give notice, that it hath been certified to me in writing under the hands of two Members, serving in this present Parliament in the manner required by the said Act, that Henry Torrens Anstruther, Esq., late a Member serving in this present Parliament for the St. Andrews District Burghs, hath accepted the office of a Representative of the British Government in the Conseil d'Administration of the Suez Canal Company, and has been gazetted thereto in the London Gazette dated the twenty-fifth day of August, 1903, and has thereby vacated his seat, and that I shall issue my Warrant to the Clerk of the Crown to make out a New Writ for the electing of a Member to serve in this present Parliament for the said St. Andrews District Burghs at the end of six days after the insertion of this notice in the London Gazette.
