[The bearings are magnetic, and those concerning the visibility of lights are given from seaward.]

No. 682.—MADAGASCAR, EAST COAST— TAMATAVE.

Tanio Point Beacon—Light Established on.

The French Government has given notice, dated 3rd August, 1903, that a white fixed light, elevated 28 feet above high water, has been established on the beacon on Tanio Point, Tamatave. This light in line with the light (white fixed sector) on Tanio Point N. 39° W. leads through the South Pass.

The power of the Beacon Light is about one-third of that of Tanio Point Light.

The staff supporting the topmark of the Beacon is painted white.

Approximate position, lat. 18° 8' S., long. 49° 26' E.

No. 683.—AFRICA, EAST COAST—BRITISH EAST AFRICA.

Port Malindi—Light Established.

The Government of British East Africa has given notice that, on August 1st, 1903, a white fixed light, elevated 69 feet above high water, and visible in clear weather from a distance of 11 miles from the bearing of N. 5° E., through north and west, to S. 45° W., would be established on an iron mast erected 184 yards S. 17° W. from Vasco da Gama's Pillar, Port Malindi.

Approximate position, lat. 3° 13½' S., long. 40° 8' E.

The light is of the 6th order.
