SUMMARY JURISDICTION ACT, 1879.

In pursuance of section 1 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, notice is hereby given that after the expiration of 40 days from the date of the publication of this notice, the Lord Chancellor proposes to make a rule under section 29 of the Summary Jurisdiction Act, 1879, settling the form of the certificate mentioned in Rule 13 of the Summary Jurisdiction Rules, 1886, with reference to the taking of recognizances by the Governor of a Prison.

FACTORY AND WORKSHOP ACT, 1901.

In pursuance of section 1 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Home Department proposes, at the expiration of 40 days from the publication of this notice, to make an Order under section 49 of the Factory and Workshop Act, 1901, consolidating with amendments the existing Orders relating to the overtime employment of women on not more than 30 days in any twelve months, viz., the Orders dated the 20th December, 1882, the 22nd November, 1883, the 12th March, 1884, the 27th August, 1884, the 26th April, 1887, the 16th September, 1889, the 13th October, 1890, the 7th September, 1896, the 30th June, 1897, the 28th June, 1899, the 27th June, 1902, and the 18th June, 1903; which Orders will be thereby revoked.
