The unsecured creditors and the preferential creditors to be paid forthwith. 2. With regard to the creditors in list "B," the following arrangements to be made:—"A." That as to the debt due to Mr. George Lovibond: mutual conveyances be executed of moieties of the property by Aaron Heyward and the bankrupt, and that the sum of £115 be paid by the bankrupt to Mr. Lovibond, and the remaining sum of £100 being lent to the bankrupt on mortgage at 4 per cent. as arranged prior to the bankruptcy, such sum of £115 to be paid by the bankrupt to include all Mr. Lovibond's mortgagees and bankruptcy costs. "B." That with regard to the mortgage debt due from the said Aaron Heyward and the bankrupt to Mr. W. C. H. Cross, the said bankrupt agrees to pay the sum of £100 to Mr. W. C. H. Cross, and to take a conveyance in severalty of a portion of the land as arranged, the bankrupt executing a mortgage to Mr. W. C. H. Cross for the sum of £400 at 4 per cent., the bankrupt paying no mortgagees costs. "C." That with regard to the mortgage debt due from the said Aaron Heyward and the bankrupt to Messrs. Strickland and Fletcher, the bankrupt executing a conveyance of his equity of redemption in the property at present mortgaged to them, the said Messrs. Strickland and Fletcher, withdrawing all claims against the said bankrupt. 3. As to two creditors partly secured set out in list "C." "A." That with regard to the claim by the Trustees under the marriage settlement executed by the bankrupt, the bankrupt proposes, in addition to the security now held by the said Trustees, to give a second mortgage on twenty plots of the New Clifton Building Estate, estimated to produce at present value more than 7s. 6d. in the pound on the provable claim of the said Trustees to further secure the said sum of £5,000, the Trustees to release the said bankrupt in consideration of this further security from his personal covenant to pay the said sum of £5,000. The bankrupt to pay all costs of the bankruptcy forthwith. The Scheme providing reasonable security for payment of not less than 7s. 6d. in the pound on all unsecured debts provable against the debtor's estate. The Order for Adjudication, dated the 22nd day of March, 1902, against the said Lewis Frederick Shove to be annulled, and the Receiving Order, dated the 19th day of November, 1901, to be discharged.</p>
