WILD BIRD (ENGLAND).

The Wild Birds Protection (County Borough of West Bromwich) Order, 1904.

Dated 6th February, 1904.

In pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the Wild Birds Protection Acts, 1880 to 1902, and upon application by the Council of the County Borough of West Bromwich, I hereby make the following Order:—

Title.

I. This Order may be cited as the Wild Birds Protection (County Borough of West Bromwich) Order, 1904.

BIRDS.

Close Time extended.

II. The period during which the killing or taking of Wild Birds is prohibited by the Wild Birds Protection Act, 1880, shall be extended throughout the County Borough of West Bromwich so as to be between the last day of February and the 13th day of August in any year.

Additions to the Schedule of the Act of 1880.

III. The Wild Birds Protection Act, 1880, shall apply within the County Borough of West
