

"Now therefore, with the consent of the said Hardinge Stanley, Earl of Halsbury, acting on behalf of Your Majesty as aforesaid (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this scheme) and with the consent of the said John Bishop of Saint David's acting as such Bishop (in testimony whereof he has affixed his hand and episcopal seal to this scheme) we the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England humbly recommend and propose that upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this scheme and without any conveyance or assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the whole advowson or perpetual right of patronage of and presentation to each of the six benefices described in the first part of the schedule hereto and the churches thereof respectively shall be assigned and transferred from Your Majesty and shall become and be absolutely vested in and shall and may from time to time and at all times be exercised by the said John Bishop of Saint David's and his successors Bishops of the same diocese for ever, and that in

exchange for the advowsons or perpetual rights of patronage of or presentation to the said six benefices and churches the whole advowson or perpetual right of patronage of and presentation to each of the four benefices described in the second part of the schedule hereto and the churches thereof respectively shall in like manner and upon and from the same date be assigned and transferred from the said John Bishop of Saint David's and be absolutely vested in Your Majesty Your Heirs and Successors in right of the Crown and shall and may from time to time and at all times be exercised by the said Hardinge Stanley, Earl of Halsbury, or other the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain for the time being acting on behalf of Your Majesty Your Heirs and Successors.

"And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or any of them in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts or of either of them or of any other Act of Parliament.
